A MOTION WAS MADE BY <u>SZWACZKA</u> AND SECONDED BY <u>WYGONIK</u> TO ACCEPT THE JULY 18TH, 2023 MEETING MINUTES.

FIRST MATTER OF BUSINESS WAS SITE PLAN WAIVER APPLICATION FOR A NAIL AND BROW SALON FROM MAGDALENA MICHALOW - 46 WALLINGTON AVE, BLOCK 15, LOT 25.

MS. MICHALOW DESCRIBED HER BUSINESS AS A NAIL SALON WITH BODY WAXING WITH A TOTAL OF 3 EMPLOYEES. OPERATED MONDAY TO FRIDAY FROM 9 AM TO 6 PM AND SATURDAY MORNING. GARBAGE DUMPSTER PRESENT AT THE LOCATION. BUSINESS WILL NOT PRODUCE A LOT OF GARBAGE. KNOX BOX ALREADY INSTALLED.

CHAIRMAN BAGINSKI ASKED THE OWNER OF THE BUILDING – JAROSLAW SZWED - TO BE SWORN IN AND ANSWER SOME QUESTIONS FROM THE BOARD MEMBERS. MR. SZWED WAS INFORMED ABOUT THE NECESSITY OF COMPLYING WITH THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) PROTOCOLS AND WAS TOLD THAT A HANDICAP PARKING SPACES ARE MANDATORY. MEMBERS SUGGESTED THAT THE WHOLE



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PARKING LOT NEEDS TO BE RESTRIPED BECAUSE THE LINES ARE NOT VISIBLE. SZWED SAID THAT HE WILL TAKE CARE OF THE LANDSCAPING. CHAIRMAN BAGINSKI ALSO REMINDED THE OWNER ABOUT A BOROUGH SIGN ORDINANCE. HE ASKED THE OWNER TO ALSO CONTACT THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT, SO THE NEW SIGN WOULD COMPLY WITH THE BOROUGH RULES.
